2010 San Antonio Festival Tour (April 14-18, 2010)

TRIP COST

The total cost will be between \$525 and \$550 per student. This quote is based on 160 students attending. Please be advised the cost per student will change, based on the final number of students who elect to attend. Because of this, we will not be able to provide you with a final cost for the trip until we confirm the number of students attending and secure that number through a non-refundable deposit (required by DC festivals, our hosts in San Antonio).

PAYMENT PLAN

We are obligated by contract to pay DC Festivals in several installments, with the first payment due in December and the last due in March. To meet our payment deadlines, we have established a payment plan for you. We have divided the cost of the trip into four payments. The first payment is a **\$100 non-refundable deposit required by DC Festivals**. Please make all payments by the dates indicated. If your child has raised money through Band fundraisers, that amount may be deducted from your payment.

January 15, 2010	\$100 non-refundable deposit
February 15, 2010	\$250
March 15, 2010	Remaining Balance

We intend to adjust the last payment to reflect the total amount of the trip.

REIMBURSEMENT

Per our contract with our host festival committee, all cancellations must be made in writing. Cancellation charges are as follows:

<u>Time period</u>	<u>Cancellation Charge</u>
Up to March 15, 2010	No charge
After March 15, 2010	100% of package price, plus nonrefundable registration fee
No-Show	100% of package price, plus nonrefundable registration fee

Registration Fee/Deposit - non-refundable

In the event a student is not permitted to attend the festival due to circumstances beyond her/his control (such as sudden illness, hospitalization, family death, emergency), the Executive Board may make exceptions to the charges above, on a case-by-case basis. If a child is ineligible and has signed up for a room and hotel, he/she will be assessed **100%** of the trip, so plan accordingly
