

Minutes of the La Cueva Band Booster General Meeting  
April 29, 2015

Present: Pres. Jeff Hawkins, VP Celina Stoyanof, VP Matt Shover, secretary Vicki Porter, treasurer Diane Fehrenbach, director John Converse, and approximately 20 other members.

Meeting called to order at 7:03 p.m.

1) **Minutes:** A motion to approve the minutes from the March 4, 2015, meeting was made and seconded. Motion to approve minutes carried.

2) **Elections for 2015-2016 La Cueva Band Booster Executive Board:** President Jeff Hawkins reviewed the slate presented at the March 4<sup>th</sup> meeting by the nominating committee. After requesting nominations from the floor for each office and receiving no additional nominations, a motion was made and seconded to elect the full Nominating Committee slate as presented. 3) **Director's Report:** Wind Ensemble placed 2<sup>nd</sup> at State with an outstanding performance. Recent Winter Guard competition hosted by La Cueva went very well, many thanks to Edwin. The band has received music for the 1<sup>st</sup> movement for the 2015 marching show based on metallic elements. There currently over 50 incoming students registered so the band should be somewhat larger next year. However, guard numbers are very low. Mr. Converse is putting together a list of dates to be distributed to students before the end of the school year. AP Music Theory will be offered next year and students may still register for it. The marching band will be going to Las Cruces for TOB this year but not to BOA in Utah.

4) **Spring Trip:** It was a very successful trip. Final cost was \$625. The accounts on the website will be updated to final balances by the end of the school year. It worked very well staying by the Alamo and the only times the students were on busses were to/from the competition and to Six Flags. All groups had very good performances at the competition. Next year's spring trip is tentatively planned for Los Angeles.

Next meeting will be the Parent meeting following band camp in August.
