

Minutes of the La Cueva Band Booster General Meeting

November 4, 2015

Present: President Jennifer Mullens, 1st VP Celina Stoyanof, 2nd VP Matt Shover, Treasurer Diane Fehrenbach, Secretary Penny Tennant, Director of Bands, John Converse, members of Student Board and approximately 30 members.

Meeting called to order at 7:01 p.m.

- 1) **Minutes:** A motion was made to approve the minutes of the September 2nd, 2015 meeting from Tim O'Brien and seconded Carmine Kavelman. The Motion passed.
- 2) **Mr. Converse** – busy day tomorrow with all-state tryouts and football – report time 5:45. If kids need to be driven by parents to a game, then they have to be picked up by a parent. May cancel zero hour on Friday – no props. 6 am report for TOB, might be back 2 to 3am. (TOB is mandatory.) TOB enters opposite side of field. – will practice on Friday.
Thursday & Friday next week is tryouts for Concert Band. No scales. Dec 4th – tour to middle schools for Wind Ensemble only. If a student can't go, they need to let Mr. C know right away. 4 bands for basketball. Each band member does 2 games unless they go to state and district. Christmas concert – jazz -8th of Dec, Concert 10th. Drill was late this year from designer. Need by Sept 15th next year. Learned a lot this season – how to paint field, changes in rehearsals. Now top 5 at ZIA – program going well. Probably will have largest freshman class ever next year. Working on show for next year.
Mr. Shover took nice pictures of band. Thanked parent volunteers.
- 3) Daniel Kavelman – 3 fundraisers. 7:45 to 9:45. Come with a ticket and you pay \$8 and we get \$2 at Texas Meltz – private event – will be fun. Chipotle – Nov 16th – will have flyers. Nov 21st – goodwill fundraiser – 9-1pm. Here. Dec 3rd at twisters 15%. Applebee's. Dec 12th – pancake breakfast – student volunteers – tickets sold – get to keep money from all tickets sold. Question – will there be a tax donation form?
- 4) **Treasurer:** \$33,000 towards craft fair – 8,000 over budget – officers made \$1900 so far. Taxes done. \$2400. Show a little under budget. PayPal - now have account 2.2 % charge + .30 . use friends and family for cash and goods and services with credit.
- 5) **Fundraising:** Adrian Sanchez – presented fundraisers. Spring trip. Gold canyon fundraiser – for student accounts. Starts today – checks need to be written to family and one check to band account. Due Nov 20th. Another version for February. Have to turn in order by 22nd. Packaged as a gift. (Mr. C addressed expectations for Spring Trip – reward for hard work, but also educational – not mandatory.)
Celina Stoyanof – poinsettias coming around Dec 3rd. Spring Trip – we can save money by doing our own reservations. Trying to get costs down. Each bus is \$6000 x 3. The competition is at the Rose Theater. Awards at Disneyland. Trying to get 'hopper' ticket. \$10-15-20 for meals. Use tax-exempts to save money. Spend entire day at competition. Tried to get all activities arranged by tonight, but not everything arranged yet. All-inclusive trip.
- 6) **President:** if you commit and don't go, you lose your money. If you don't commit by the deadline, you don't go. Send out forms next week. Also need to register online. Thanked everyone for coming.
