

Minutes of the La Cueva Band Booster General Meeting

September 7th, 2016

Meeting called to order at 7:02 p.m.

- 1) President introduces board members.
- 2) **Minutes:** A motion was made to approve the minutes of the May meeting by Luanne Hartman from Dale Patton seconded. The Motion passed.
- 3) **Student Board:** Jenny Hartman President, Andrew Chang VP, Tori Malone Treasurer, Megan Rivera Secretary, Car Wash Sept 17th 9-2 at Dearholt. \$5 per ticket. Need parent volunteers and clean towels. Community awareness. Board has made \$600 so far on Bahama Bucks and flip books. Car wash can make \$1500 to \$2000 if weather good. Music honor society. Paperwork will be put on website. Banquet will be at school or a park and probably potluck.

- 5) **Treasurer:** balance sheets at door.
- 6) **Letterman Jacket Fundraiser:** Amy O’Brien: Oct 12th – 5:30 to 8pm fittings. \$250 to \$300 total. Student get \$20 per jacket sold, and 7% tax savings.
- 7) **Chocolate Fundraiser:** Mike Stordahl; don’t sell at school.
- 8) **President:** Pomona trip – going to CO earlier. During balloon fiesta, have to use non-local busses. Having flea market to offset trip costs of max \$250 per kid. Other fundraisers to offset Spring trip costs. Need paperwork back for trip next Monday. Spring trip is Phoenix.
- 9) **Director of Bands:** really crucial to have the entire band and CG be at every marching competition. District athletics not allowing as many stadium rehearsals. Hoping to make a field in a back parking lot. All construction on hold due to lawsuit. PE credit: asking for waiver. Wants kids to practice more. 30 minutes a day. Would like to be better prepared for Pomona. September 16th is 8th grade night. Music in for honors concert. Students may audition for wind symphony. All state music coming soon, kids who have private instructors have their music; available at Baums, jazz cycle 2 available at NMMEA website. Must try out for all state to try out for wind symphony. Props looking good. Saturday rehearsal went well. Looking forward to finished product.
