

Minutes of the La Cueva Band Booster General Meeting

November 2, 2016

Present: President Ingrid Wobst, 1st VP Luanne Stordahl, 2nd VP Charles Parisseau, Secretary Penny Tennant, Director of Bands: John Converse, and approximately 20 members.

Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m.

- 1) TOB – report 5pm. Everyone needs to bring a blanket and pillow. It may be cold in the stands. May rain. Buses stay and we have rain gear. Matt Staten has emailed crew.
- 2) Craft fair – email will go out to committee. Have vendors and layout. Have bakesale permit.
- 3) Student board – all present. Have Chipotle fundraiser January 30th. 50% profits go to band. Goodwill fundraiser in the Spring. Also a car wash. The money goes to the end of year budget. Trying for cheaper banquet. End of marching season party. At outpost ice skating. Nov 19th. Community outreach. Charity food drive. At winter concert, ask for canned foods and other non-perishable food. Saturday or Friday after concert – roadrunner foodbank.
- 4) **Mr. Car Wash fundraiser** – Rhonda Baker – fundraiser for student accounts. \$10 each – express \$6. 4 weeks to sell and turn in money starting now. Only receive \$500 worth of tickets at a time, then we can reorder. Secretary will send out email blast. Make a copy of your order form. Rhonda will come back in two weeks to give out tickets.
- 5) **Minutes:** A motion was made to approve the minutes of the October meeting by Tim O’Brien and Celia Smith seconded. The Motion passed.
- 6) **President:** We are doing well with volunteers this year. Have room for chaperones for TOB trip. Spring trip – letter of intent handed out. Cost is \$600, but will probably be as low as \$550. More of a music performance and workshop program. Performance exchange. Baseball game, instrument museum and amusement park. Intent form due December 3rd. Field show paying off this year. 3rd time winning POB and many caption awards. Won People choice award. ZIA finish highest ever. Clovis has had an incredible band and deserved 1st place. Got great crowd response. Good feedback from colleagues. Great middle school feeders. Kids working hard. Good buzz about La Cueva show. Final rehearsal at Wilson 3-5pm. Uncoupling marching band from concert will not happen next year.
